Spring has come and gone - summer is here with the bounty of the flowering of the gardens. Our treasury has a positive balance but I am concerned about the future.

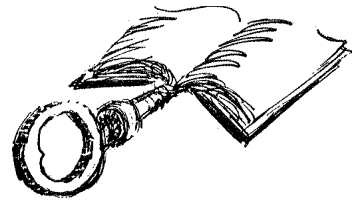
I hope that everyone has a bountiful harvest this year and you are prospering on your spiritual path.

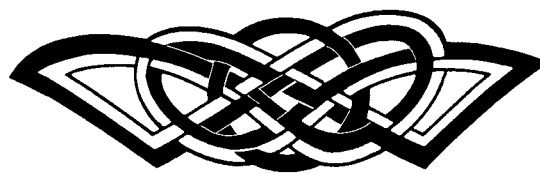

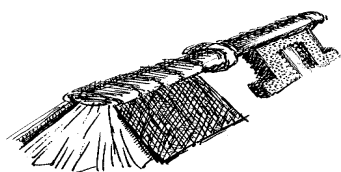

## MORGAINÉ

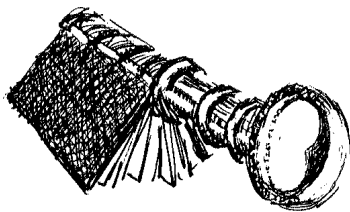
In the rain-sweet air of a night

By her hand I am mist to envelop the fay.

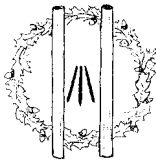

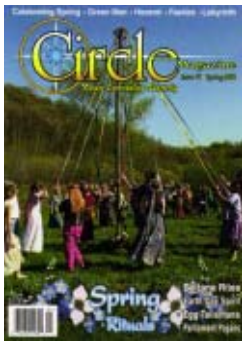

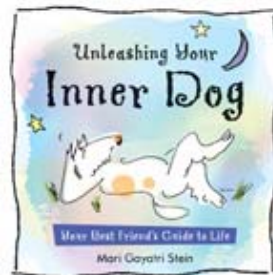
