## CONGRATULATIONS TO THE GRANDPARENTS!

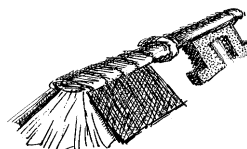
The Stork is flying low around the Henge. President Wren and Trustee Tony became grandparents this past November 27th with the birth of a granddaughter

serene knowledge is within her grasp

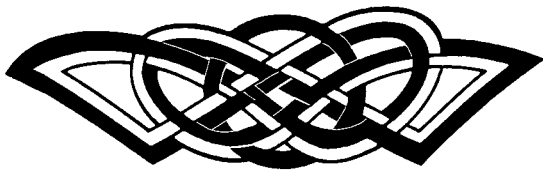
A daughter of the highest lunation
